





### A Look Back

- First stage of fiscal cliff negotiations were reached in the early hours of Jan. 1, 2013
  - Extended the Bush-Era Tax cuts on everyone but singles making \$400,000 per year and couples making \$450,000
    - Many other tax issues resolved and extended
  - Sequestration delayed for two months until March 1
  - Debt limit untouched







## A Look Back (cont'd)

The delayed sequester did not come without a price.

- Total cost of the delay was \$24 billion \$12 billion paid for by cutting discretionary funds
  - \$6 billion from defense
  - \$6 billion from non-defense discretionary















#### Trend Chart: Devices financed by AT type












